



Sanfield opens one-day “cha chaan teng” for the elderly 新辉为长者开设一日“茶餐厅”

Sanfield (Management), the Group’s construction arm, partnered with Rainbow Foundation and Noah’s Ark Hong Kong at Ma Wan Park to organize a unique community programme aimed at fostering social engagement among the elderly. The Harvest Restaurant at Noah’s Ark was transformed into a Hong Kong-style cafe, hosting nearly 100 senior citizens from St. James’ Settlement. Over 40 members of the Sanfield Connect Volunteer Team served as waiters, sharing meals with the participants and listening to their personal stories. The initiative blended local cultural elements with life education, providing emotional support and promoting mental wellness.

Sanfield will continue to leverage its influence within the construction sector to roll out creative volunteer services with industry and community partners, contributing to sustainable social development. Following the pop-up cafe event, Sanfield Connect is now planning to launch the Cafe de Sanfield - Takeaway Edition. Subcontractors are invited to join this new initiative to deliver care and support to approximately 200 senior citizens.

为鼓励长者多投入社交生活，集团旗下建筑部门新辉（建筑管理），近月特别与 Rainbow Foundation 及香港马湾公园挪亚方舟，合办一个别开生面的关怀长者活动——将挪亚方舟的餐厅丰盛阁化身成港式冰室，招待近百位来自圣雅各福群会的长者。40多位来自“新辉延爱”的义工队成员，不仅充当一天的服务生，还成为长者们的“饭友”，一边品尝美食，一边细听他们分享人生故事，借著这个糅合港式情怀和生命教育元素的活动，传递关怀及促进精神健康。

展望未来，新辉将继续发挥其在建筑业界的影响力，与业界及社区伙伴携手推动创新义工服务，推动社会可持续发展。“新辉延爱”继开设期间限定茶餐厅后，现正筹划推出“新辉冰室外卖篇”，并号召判商加入义工行列，预计为 200 名长者送上关怀与祝福。
