



Sanfield opens one-day “cha chaan teng” for the elderly 新輝為長者開設一日「茶餐廳」

Sanfield (Management), the Group’s construction arm, partnered with Rainbow Foundation and Noah’s Ark Hong Kong at Ma Wan Park to organize a unique community programme aimed at fostering social engagement among the elderly. The Harvest Restaurant at Noah’s Ark was transformed into a Hong Kong-style café, hosting nearly 100 senior citizens from St. James’ Settlement. Over 40 members of the Sanfield Connect Volunteer Team served as waiters, sharing meals with the participants and listening to their personal stories. The initiative blended local cultural elements with life education, providing emotional support and promoting mental wellness.

Sanfield will continue to leverage its influence within the construction sector to roll out creative volunteer services with industry and community partners, contributing to sustainable social development. Following the pop-up café event, Sanfield Connect is now planning to launch the Café de Sanfield - Takeaway Edition. Subcontractors are invited to join this new initiative to deliver care and support to approximately 200 senior citizens.

為鼓勵長者多投入社交生活，集團旗下建築部門新輝（建築管理），近月特別與 Rainbow Foundation 及香港馬灣公園挪亞方舟，合辦一個別開生面的關懷長者活動——將挪亞方舟的餐廳豐盛閣化身成港式冰室，招待近百位來自聖雅各福群會的長者。40多位來自「新輝延愛」的義工隊成員，不僅充當一天的侍應生，還成為長者們的「飯友」，一邊品嚐美食，一邊細聽他們分享人生故事，藉著這個糅合港式情懷和生命教育元素的活動，傳遞關懷及促進精神健康。

展望未來，新輝將繼續發揮其在建築業界的影響力，與業界及社區夥伴攜手推動創新義工服務，推動社會可持續發展。「新輝延愛」繼開設期間限定茶餐廳後，現正籌劃推出「新輝冰室外賣篇」，並號召分判商加入義工行列，預計為200名長者送上關懷與祝福。
